SAFETY & SECURITY

- Enhance the secure entryway
- Install exterior card access
- Add additional security cameras
- Upgrade clocks to digital with message display capability
- Replace the fire alarm panel

LEARNING ENVIRONMENT

- Renovate the robotics room, kitchen, cafeteria, restrooms, and office
- Remodel upstairs to PAES lab (employment skill building)
- Add a restroom to the upstairs instructional space

EXTERIOR & SITE

- Replace exterior doors and windows
- update building facade
- Add LED site sign

INSTRUCTIONAL & NON-INSTRUCTIONAL TECHNOLOGY EQUIPMENT

- Replace instructional and non-instructional technology
 - provide interactive instruction boards for classrooms (replacing obsolete projectors with a more versatile teaching tool)

- Purchase furniture to update and complete PAES Lab, cafeteria and office area
