- Registration: Registration documentation will be online through PowerSchool, where you will digitally sign your students' emergency cards and support documents. We are currently waiting for the final transition to PowerSchool to enable this process. There will be an email coming from the district that will open the window and provide directions on how and when to complete this process. Once this process is open, students will not be able to access their schedules or attend classes until this vital safety information is collected.

- Sophomores, Juniors, and Seniors: We will <u>not</u> have an in-person registration. Schedules will be released late in the week of August 19st through PowerSchool, if your parents/guardians/caregivers have completed the on-line registration information.
- **Freshmen**: Registration/Orientation will take place on Tuesday, August 20th from 9-11 am. Please see the information below for this event:
 - Freshman registration/orientation will be held on 8/20 from 9-11am
 - All 9th grade students should enter through the front vestibule by at least 9 am.
 - Parents are welcome to join their students and accompany them for registration activities
 - Students will engage in the following:
 - School scavenger hunt
 - Find your classes
 - Auditorium welcome from principals and student leadership
 - Review of school policies
 - Exposure to extracurricular activities
 - If parents are not accompanying students for registration activities, they should be prepared to pick students up at 11:00am
 - Note: There will be an Informational Meeting for 9th grade parents/guardians/caregivers on Tuesday, August 28th, at 6:30 pm in the high school auditorium.
- New/Returning Students to Avondale High School: Since our registration is online (except for Freshmen), we would like to welcome any new/returning students, and their families, that would like to walk the building on Monday August 19th, from 12:30-2:30 pm. Please note that schedules may not be ready at this time due to the transfer to PowerSchool.
- **Schedules:** Will not be released until the week of August 19th. Schedule changes will be accepted through the first five days of school (ending on Tuesday, September 6th, at 2:30 pm) for the following reasons:
 - Students should ONLY request a schedule change if the schedule contains errors, the student has already taken the class, for medical reasons (i.e. PE), when a teacher

initiates a schedule change based on his/her assessment of a student's skills, or due to other extenuating circumstances that are approved by a counselor or administrator. Change requests submitted for items such as lunch changes, teacher changes, etc. will not be accepted.

- Honors and Advanced Placement classes cannot be changed.
- If there are extenuating circumstances (i.e. injury that makes PE impossible), please communicate with your student's counselor.
- Note: Any year-long class (as designated in the curriculum guide) will not be able to be dropped or switched at the semester mark.

well as, our Safe Ed team regarding school safety. We will continue to adapt our protocols as situations arise. We ask that you converse with your students about appropriate behaviors, letting others know about issues that your students witness, and taking an active role in creating the culture and environment they want to be a part of.
