EXPECTATIONS OF NHS MEMBERS

- Maintain a 3.5 unweighted cumulative GPA (checked at semesters).
- Pay the \$15.00 membership dues annually.
- Miss no more than 1 meeting per year. There will be one meeting monthly at 6:45 a.m., typically the second Tuesday of every month unless otherwise noted.
- Be a part of **at least one** tutoring day (whether elementary, middle school or high school) per month.
- Complete **25 service hours per semester**. These hours should include at least 20 Inside* Hours. Only 5 Outside** Hours per semester can be used toward your total of 25 hours. NHS service hours should be submitted to Ms. Mancini at every monthly meeting.
- Sign up Genius should be used to sign up for Inside Hours/NHS sponsored events. The No Show Policy includes probation/possible dismissal.
- Be on time to the monthly 6:45 a.m. meetings. Attendance will be taken.
2 Tardies=1 Absence (Tardy is defined as more than 5min late)
2nd Absence=Probation
3rd Absence=Possible Dismissal
Any school violations can also lead to dismissal from NHS ex. Cheating, fighting, suspensions, etc.
- National Honor Society Induction is MANDATORY for members and inductees. NHS Induction will be **December 5th, 2018**, at 6:00 p.m. in the evening.
- It is MANDATORY for members to participate in the NHS approved group service project(s).

***NHS Sponsored Events/Inside Hours:** These are hours that are earned through service that is made available to you through the NHS. Typically, inside hours consist of but are not limited to Academic Support Tutoring, Elementary and Middle School Tutoring Programs, Avondale Events (Conferences, Open House, Graduation, etc.), Avondale HS Office Help, Group Service Project, etc.

****NON NHS Sponsored Events/Outside Hours:** These are hours that you earn through opportunities that you find on your own. Although, occasionally, the NHS Advisers may facilitate an outside request via the NHS member email list. The email will clearly state that the hours are classified as Outside. These hours include volunteering at area hospitals, community service programs through church, soup kitchens, senior center programs, volunteering at animal shelters, etc. There are many other examples of outside hour opportunities.
